INTERNSHIP

The Winter Ramp Up Internship (WRU) is a 3-week internship that prepares you for the rigor of the 2-year Kauhale YLT Internship. Upon successful completion of the Winter Ramp Up, you will be invited to the Kauhale YLT Internship. The Kauhale YLT is a unique opportunity to start your college career by obtaining an Associate of Arts degree from Leeward Community College while gaining work and leadership experience in the Kauhale Social Enterprises- MA`O Organic Farms, Mākaha Studios and Searider Productions (Digital Media internship requires graduating from WHS SP). 1st Year Interns earn \$500.00 monthly stipend, 2nd year interns earn \$600.00 monthly stipend as well as gain understanding of how to succeed in work and college environments. Interns benefit from numerous leadership opportunities and are part of a cohort that lends positive peer support.
